

# What are the classical musical instruments?

These are the musical instruments used by the classic school such as Mozart, Haydn, Beethoven, etc.

Apart from the instruments manufactured in the days of the classic school, they also include those which were once reworked to the modern specifications but have been reworked back again to the original form, as well as so called *replicas* which have been recently manufactured to the original design specifications.

In the classical instruments, the pitch A is set at 430Hz, a median between the modern instruments at 442Hz and the baroque instruments at 415Hz.

Traces of gradual improvements are noticeable in the classical musical instruments vis-à-vis the baroque musical instruments, particularly as regards the flute and the oboe.
